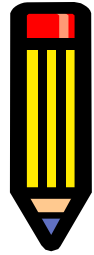


ELGIN ACADEMY KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST



All kindergartners will need to bring some supplies to school. The list includes:

The following items do not need to be labeled:

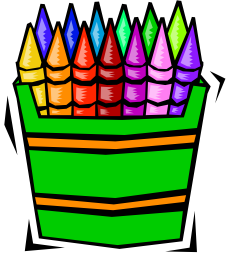
- 1 box of twistable crayons (*not erasable*)
- 1 box of jumbo (2.5 gallon) Ziploc bags
- 3 boxes of Crayola broad tip markers
- 1 box of thin Crayola markers
- 1 box of book rings - any size
- 6 large glue sticks
- 12 #2 pencils
- 1 old shirt (for painting - bigger is better)
- 2 large boxes of kleenex
- 1 1½" clearview front pocket binder
- 1 box 4x6 index cards - no lines
- 1 pink eraser (*not pencil toppers*)

Please label the following with student's name:

- 1 pair of gym shoes - **to be left at school**
- 1 change of clothing - **to be left at school**
- 1 **SPIRAL** 8 ½ x 11 or 9 x 12 artist sketchbook, 75-100 pages

Many items are available at the Varsity Store.

If you are bringing your lunch, a sturdy lunch box is recommended and be sure to write your name on it! Please bring a book bag or backpack to help you keep your belongings together.



ELGIN ACADEMY FIRST GRADE SUPPLY LIST



All first graders will need to bring some supplies to school. The list includes:

- 1 box of Crayola basic markers
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 8 large glue sticks
- 1 plastic pocket folder
- 2 containers of disinfectant wipes
- 3 dry erase markers (*no pastels*)
- 2 old white gym socks
- 1 paint shirt (*old shirts work well*)
- 20 pennies, 10 nickels, 10 dimes, 8 quarters
- 3 large erasers
- 1 pair of gym shoes **to be left at school**
- 1 change of clothing - **all articles labeled - to be left at school**
- 1 spiral notebook with pocket (*100 pages*)
- 1 plain 2" binder
- 1 package #2 pencils
- 1 **SPIRAL** 8 ½ x 11 or 9 x 12 artist sketchbook (*75-100 pages*)

We will pool all pencils, erasers, markers, glue and crayons - please do not label.

Please keep them generic; no fancy pencils.

Many items are available at the Varsity Store.

Carrying your lunch in a brown bag is fine, but if you choose to buy a lunch box, **please put your name on it.** A book bag is also helpful.



ELGIN ACADEMY SECOND GRADE SUPPLY LIST



All second graders will need to bring some supplies to school on or before the first day.
The list includes:

- 1 box Crayola thin markers (*washable are great*)
- 1 box Crayola thick markers (*washable are great*)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 box of **colored** pencils
- 2 large erasers - **not labeled**
- 3 packages of pencil top erasers
- 4 large glue sticks - **not labeled**
- 1 bottle of glue - **not labeled**
- 1 **Nylon** pencil pouch - **labeled**
- 1 pair of children's scissors - **labeled**
- 1 pair of gym shoes
- 2 **SPIRAL** notebooks (*70 pages*) - **labeled**
- 3 containers of disinfectant wipes
- 1 paint smock (old shirts work well) - **labeled**
- 20 pennies, 5 nickels, 10 dimes, 4 quarters enclosed in a resealable sandwich bag - **labeled**
- 1 package #2 pencils (plain) - **not labeled**
- 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags
- 3 dry erase markers, any color
- 1 **SPIRAL** 8 ½ x 11 or 9 x 12 artist sketchbook
(*75-100 pages*) - **labeled**

It is time once again to be thinking about school. As you gather the supplies on the list below, also include the novel, **Good Grief...Third Grade** by Colleen O'Shanghnessy McKenna. We will be doing activities that relate to this novel, so please read this book carefully before the start of school.

- 1 box of regular classic Crayola markers
- 1 box of thin classic Crayola markers
- 1 large box of colored Crayola pencils
- 24 #2 pencils
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 pair of good working scissors
- 1 spiral notebook (*the thinner variety with holes to put in binder*)
- 2 large Crayola glue sticks
- 2 assignment notebooks from the Varsity Store (8 ½" x 11")
- 1 school box (*no bigger than a cigar box but big enough to hold markers*)
- 1 highlighter
- 1 1½" binder with pockets on the inside covers -
no Trapper Keepers or zipper binders
- 1 package 3x5 lined index cards
- 1 **SPIRAL** 8 ½ x 11 or 9 x 12 artist sketchbook (*75-100 pages*)

PLEASE AVOID THE LARGE ZIPPERED BINDERS AS DESK SPACE IS LIMITED

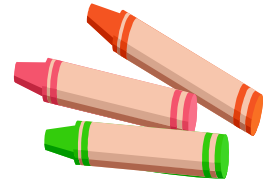
PLEASE TRY TO LIMIT SCHOOL SUPPLIES TO THOSE LISTED ABOVE.

- 3 packages of loose leaf filler paper
- 1 box regular Crayola classic color markers

- 1 box Crayola colored pencils

- 3 Elmers glue pens (non wrinkle)
- 1 Scotch glue stick
- 1 pair scissors - small size
- 1 compass - **simple design**
- 1 protractor Helix - plastic
- 1 ruler - cm. and inches (not flexible)
- 1 package 2 x 2½ post-it-notes (any color)
- 1 package 3 x 5 lined index cards
- 2 large size assignment notebooks from the Varsity Store
- 5 double pocket **plastic** folders (***no pictures***)
- 5 plastic report covers (with slider)
- 4 containers of disinfectant wipes
- 1 black and white composition book (*100 pages*)
- 2 packages of yellow 5 pocket dividers (reinforced)
- 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags
- 1 box of quart size Ziploc bags
- 1 package **Expo** dry erase fine point markers with erasers
- 1 plain 2" binder - **NO TRAPPER KEEPS OR ZIPPER BINDERS**
