*Listed below are supplies that you will need beginning on the first day of school.  
Be sure to mark your name on all of your belongings.*

**Supplies**

- 1 assignment notebook (can be purchased at Varsity Store)
- 1 (11x14) plastic accordion folder/multi-section (Social Studies)
- 1 (3) subject spiral notebook (black/Social Studies)
- 1 single subject spiral notebook with perforated sheets for tearing out (70/80 pages; any color for French or Spanish)
- 1 spiral Art sketchbook (75-100 pages)
- 3 three-ring binders with 1" or 1 1/2" rings and a set of 5 tabbed dividers for each binder (blue for Language Arts; red for Math; green for Science)
- 3 ring binder (for Music)
- 3 packages of loose leaf paper
- 1 pocket folder for homework (any style)
- 1 canvas pencil organizer
- 2 glue sticks for Science and Language Arts (no liquid glue)
- 1 ruler (centimeter & inches)
- 2 packages of 3"x5" lined note cards
- 1 Merriam-Webster Concise School & Office dictionary
- 1 pair scissors for Science and Language Arts
- 5 blue or black pens
- 5 highlighters (different colors)
- 2 large box of tissues
- 1 large container of disinfecting wipes
- 1 box of washable color markers (at least 8 markers per box; fine point) for Social Studies
- Colored pencils (for Language Arts and Science)
- 1 (4GB) flash drive – try to find a “wearable” necklace or bracelet type
- 30 pencils with erasers
- 1 plain white T-shirt (for Lorado Taft)
- 1 black permanent marker
- 4 packages of post-it notes (2 pkgs. of 3"x 3" AND 2 pkgs. of 1 1/2" x 2")
- \*\*1 calculator, preferably Sharp EL-531WB-BL or any scientific calculator (must have square root ( √ ) and exponent keys)
